New Leadership Program (AGE 18-30) – applications now open

Applications are now open for the LSV's new 18-30 leadership program, Leadership Beyond the Flags.

Life Saving Victoria is excited to launch a new leadership development opportunity for our members aged 18 - 30.

This program has been codesigned with our 18 – 30 members through the M&LD senior development panel and aims to enhance our emerging leaders with the skills and knowledge to support members' thriving in current and future roles.
