Volunteer Role | Aquatic Sports Council (ASC)

1. Why this role matters

Powercraft plays a critical role in ensuring lifesaving sport is delivered safely across Victoria.

This role leads the Powercraft Committee, bringing together experienced volunteers to support the planning, coordination and continuous improvement of Powercraft capability for lifesaving sport. Working closely with clubs, operators, officials and LSV staff, you'll help ensure every carnival is supported by safe, capable and consistent Powercraft operations.

2. What you'll do

- Lead the Powercraft Committee and guide its annual work program.
- Work collaboratively with the Risk & Safety Lead, Summer Sports Lead, Winter Sports Lead, other Committee Chairs, committee members and LSV staff to deliver shared priorities.
- Provide leadership on the planning and coordination of Powercraft capability that supports the safe delivery of lifesaving sport.
- Attend key carnivals and championship events to engage with members and identify opportunities for improvement.
- Develop strategic advice and recommendations relating to Powercraft safety, capability, workforce development and event support.
- Lead projects and initiatives endorsed by the Aquatic Sports Council.
- Champion initiatives that strengthen Powercraft capability, volunteer development and the safe delivery of sport.
- Support the appointment, mentoring and development of committee members.
- Managing competition operations on event day.

3. What you won't be responsible for

- Managing staff or budgets.
- Making decisions on behalf of the Aquatic Sports Council Leadership Team.

This role is about leading volunteers, strengthening Powercraft sport and helping shape its future across Victoria.

4. Who this role suits

Someone who:

- Has experience in Powercraft and supporting lifesaving sport.
- Understands the role Powercraft plays in delivering safe sporting events.
- Enjoys leading volunteers and developing capability.
- Can build strong relationships across clubs, officials and event teams.
- Thinks strategically while remaining practical and solutions focused.
- Wants to strengthen the future of Powercraft within Victorian lifesaving sport.

- Attend committee meetings throughout the year.
- Attend key carnivals, planning activities and championship events.
- Participate in planning workshops and project meetings.
- Engage with committee members and stakeholders between meetings as required.
